We may also like to include a summary of your event on the National Pet Month website. Unless you tell us otherwise, we will assume you are happy for us to do this.

The prize will be awarded to the event organiser/s whose event did the best, in the opinion of the National Pet Month Trustees, to further the aims of National Pet Month. ANY event organiser is eligible to enter this competition, for ANY National Pet Month event organised during the Month, big or small. Don't think we won't be interested in the smallest event – we will.

There will be a special prize for the top fundraising event, so don't forget to tell us what you raised, and for whom.

Winners will be notified by post following a meeting of the National Pet Month Trustees after the deadline of 27<sup>th</sup> May and runners-up will be sent their certificates.

Arrangements will be made with the overall winner to present their prize. Remember, this will be an opportunity for more publicity for National Pet Month, and because we will involve your local and relevant specialist press, for your surgery, business, authority, charity, youth group or whatever type of organisation you are!
